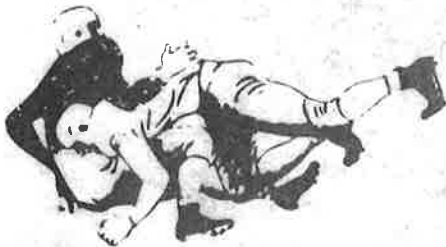
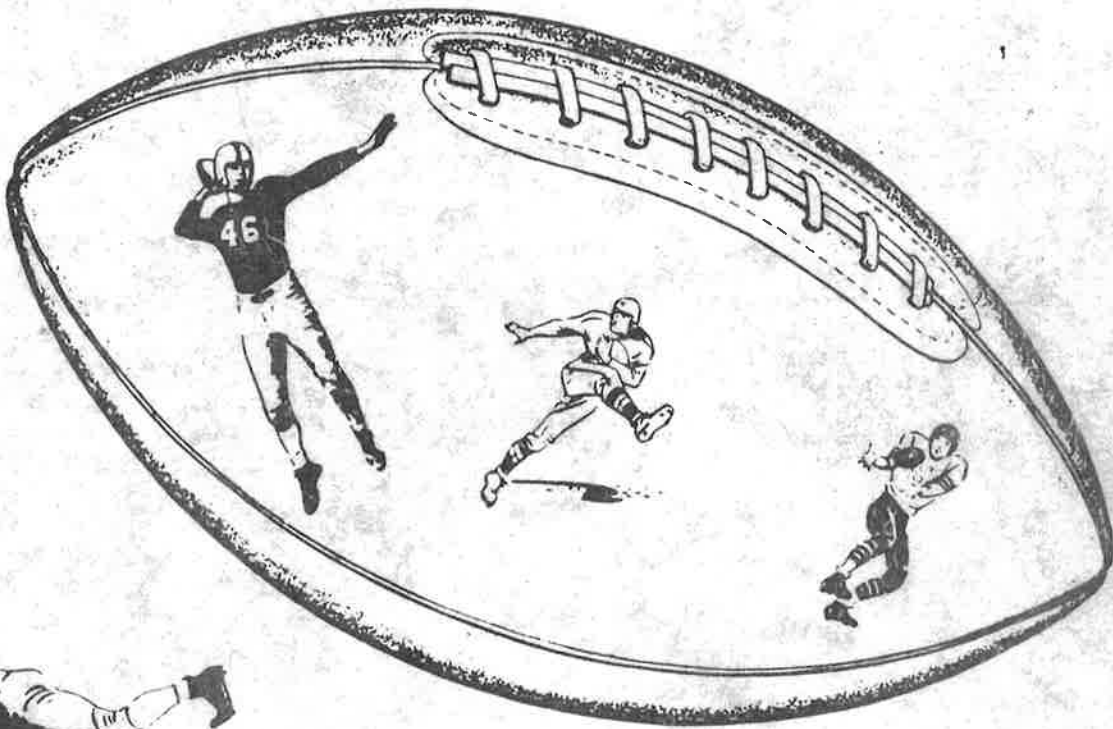

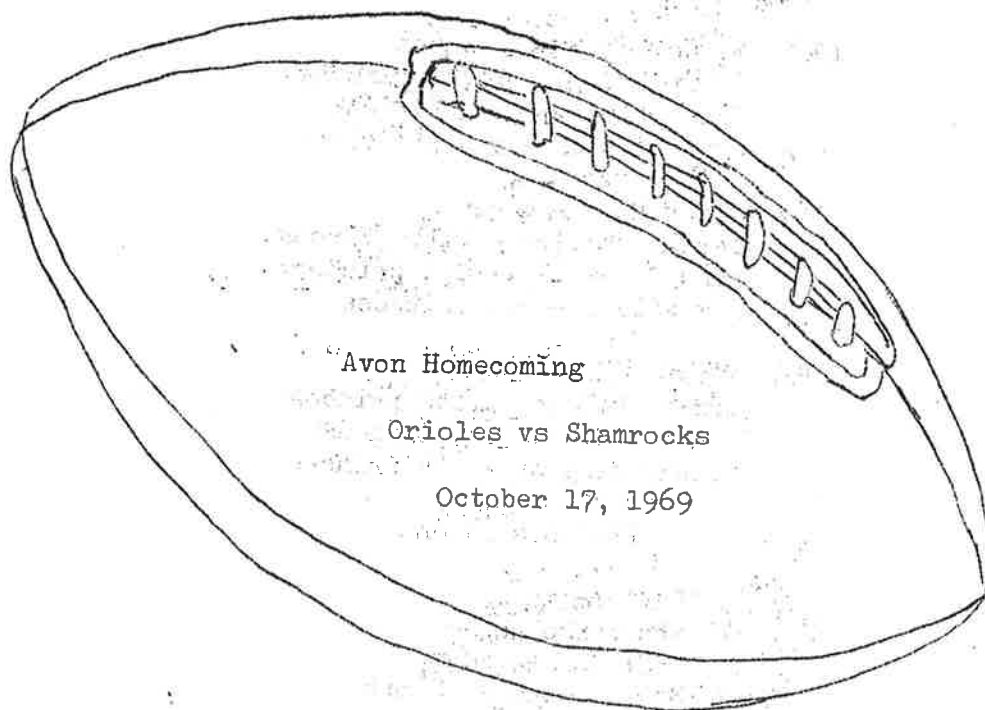

1961

Because only 23 boys went out for football, six of whom were seniors, Coach Baster's season was uphill from the very start. The varsity team consisted of inexperienced players, since this was the first year for a varsity team, this accounts for the "never-say-die" Orioles winning only one game.

After losing nine straight games the Orioles rallied for the last game of the season and defeated Plainfield's Reserve.

Even though the scores looked bad, the team played under difficult conditions. Many of these were injuries, ineligibility of the quarterback, and inexperience.

Even with all the handicaps the Orioles suffered, we feel they deserve credit for their effort and teamwork since this was only the first year for varsity football at Avon.

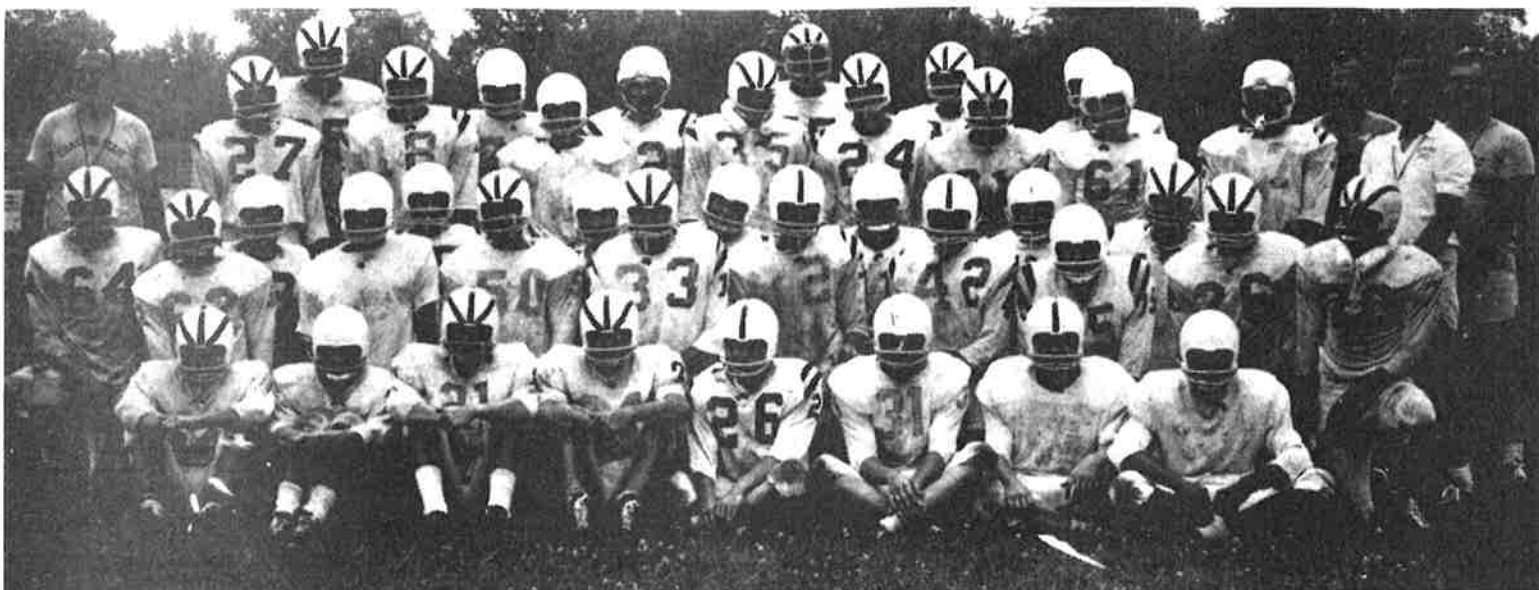
