to me than ever before.

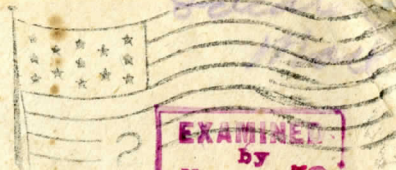
The weather has been fine
