

CHAPTER CIV.

AN ACT to amend Section Four, of an Act entitled: "An Act to authorize the formation of Companies for the Detection and Apprehension of Horse Thieves and other Felons, and for Mutual Protection, and Repealing all Laws Inconsistent Therewith." Approved, December 21, 1865; being Section 3431 of the Revised Statutes of 1881.

APPROVED APRIL 13, 1885.

Section 1. Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, That Section Four, of the above entitled Act be amended to read as follows: Section 4. A majority of the members of such Association shall have power to adopt a Constitution and By-Laws for their government; to designate and appoint a presiding officer, and such other officers as may be deemed proper, who shall hold their offices during the time, and shall perform the duties required of them by such Constitution and By-Laws, and such presiding officer is hereby authorized and empowered to administer oaths to members of such Association in all matters wherein oaths are necessary to be administered by the Rules and By-Laws of the Association, and such Association, with the consent of the Board of Commissioners of the County in which such articles are recorded, may designate any member of the Association, who in the pursuit and arrest of Horse Thieves and other offenders against Criminal Laws of the State, shall have all the powers of Constables, and such Association shall furnish to the Board of Commissioners a list of the names of members so designated, and if consent is given, the Board shall enter upon its record an order reciting the names of such persons, and that the consent of the Board has been given to such appointments, and the record so made shall authorize and empower the County Auditor to issue to each member so designated a certificate of his appointment.
