EXPLANATION.

1. The Literary Grade shows the standing of the applicant in the branches to be taught.
2. General Average is the former, modified by other evidences of professional ability, No's. 11, 12; 5 per cent of grade being added for each of last, 13 and 14.
3. General Average determines the time, 60 to 70 per cent, giving six months; 70 to 80, twelve months; 80 to 95, eighteen months; 95 to 100, twenty-four months.
4. No License is given when the general average is under 60, or the per cent of any branch under 50.
5. Teachers holding this license, are required to make a proper use of all the apparatus and educational appliances furnished by the trustees in their respective schools.
6. Examination the first Saturday in each month.
