INSTRUCTIONS

Post Commanders will have these blanks filled in immediately after the election in December, and one copy forwarded to the Assistant Adjutant-General, Indianapolis, Ind. The other copy should be retained by the Commander-elect. **All Post Commanders and Past Post Commanders in good standing, by virtue of their office, ARE MEMBERS OF THE ENCAMPMENT, AND SHOULD NOT BE ELECTED AS REPRESENTATIVES OR ALTERNATES.** The ratio of representation is as follows: Every Post is entitled to one delegate for any number of members not over fifty. Posts having over fifty members will elect one delegate for each additional fifty members, and one delegate for the last fraction over twenty-five. They will also elect as many alternates as delegates.

Posts failing to make Adjutant's and Quartermaster's reports for the term ending December 31, 1908, and pay all per capita tax due the Department, will not be admitted to representation in the Department Encampment.
